PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Onawa will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 8, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at the Onawa City Hall, 914 Diamond Street, Onawa, Iowa 51040, concerning a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application. The city will be applying for a \$529,500 CDBG grant of federal grant funds for a Water System Distribution Improvement Project replacing approximately twentyeight, 2-inch dead-end water main connections with 2-inch solid sleeve couplings, and connect to existing 2-inch through 8-inch water mains throughout the city at the following locations: Emerald Street between 13th and 14th Street; between Cameo and Ruby Street from 11th to 12th Street; between Ruby and Pearl Street from 3rd to 12th Street; Iowa Avenue between 5th and 8th Street; between Iowa Avenue and Diamond Street from 5th to 15th Street; between Diamond and Marble Street from 4th to 13th Street; between Marble and Granite Street from 4th to 17th Street and between Maple and Lucas Street from 11th to 13th Street and replace one 6-inch water main approximately 8 feet under the Union Pacific Railroad tracks with an 8- inch water main at lowa Avenue between 7th and 8th Street, and install 9 flushing hydrants. The city will submit a CDBG grant application to the lowa Economic Development Authority on or around July 1, 2021. The total estimated project cost is \$1,001,087.34. The city will provide the local match of \$491,087.34 from a General Obligation Capital Loan Note. The need for the project was identified through a Preliminary Engineering Report. The estimated portion of federal funds benefitting low-to moderate income persons (LMI) is 58.8%. There will be no displacement of persons or businesses as a result of this project; however, if unexpectedly there is displacement the city will assist all affected with the process. A Community Development and Housing Needs Assessment was conducted in November 2020. All interested parties are invited to attend this public hearing at which time they will have an opportunity to be heard regarding the project. Written or oral comments will be accepted on or before the public hearing.
